
PART I: GET SIGNED IN

1. Go to the Conference website: <https://www.eventsquid.com/event/13050> . Look at the upper right-hand corner. If your name is shown, you are already signed in and ready to go. **If you use the same computer and browser each time, you should remain signed in all week.** If you are already signed in, go to **PART II** of this document. If not, go to step 2 below.

Note: If you share this computer with other instructors, make sure it is your name that is shown. If not, click on the name and click “Sign Out” so that you can sign into your account. You only get credit for viewing sessions when you are signed into your own account, not someone else’s.

2. If you don't see your name, click "SIGN IN", and the system will ask for your email address and the password you set up when you registered for the Conference. Be sure to use the email address you used when you registered. It is the same one that this email was sent to.



3. If you don't remember your password, enter your email address and click "I forgot my password". You will see a PASSWORD RESET window. Enter your email address and click the "Verify" button.


